Drawing on the insights of neurologists and physicists, he looks at the real work of Kindergarten and its ramifications for academic achievement in primary and 2nd level school years and beyond.



A Columbia University graduate, Eugene has worked with all ages from the young child to the elderly & dying. He has lectured on new ideas in education at Harvard, Columbia, the University of Tennessee Medical Center, and the Aspen Institute.

His 30 years Steiner/Waldorf teaching at Primary & Secondary levels & as an educator of Waldorf teachers has supported the work of Waldorf initiatives worldwide, state/public schools and teachers.
